“Crisp fresh lemon peel and mountain stream rock minerality combine to create this mouth-wateringly refreshing crisp white wine from Macedonia,” explains Scocca. “This is one of my favorites at the moment and one I just recently added it to the by the glass list. If you like Pinot Grigio or any crisp white wine, then you have to try this one. Assyrtico is the name of the white grape variety which proliferates throughout the country.” He recommends trying it with Baltaire’s Baja Kampachi Crudo with cilantro, coconut, avocado, and crispy garlic. We agree.
